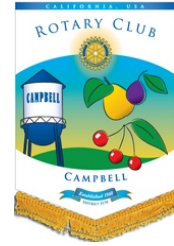

What is Rotary?

Rotary International is a service organization with 1.2 million members in 34,000 clubs in more than 160 countries. Rotary is a diverse organization, apolitical and nonsectarian, open to all faiths. A Rotary Club's membership is representative of the community it serves.

What is the Rotary Club of Campbell?

The Rotary Club of Campbell was chartered on 4 February 1948.

The Rotary Club of Campbell & San Jose West was established in 2001, the result of a spirited merger of two clubs with more than 100 combined years of Rotary service to the communities of Campbell and West San Jose – including the Westgate, Burbank, Willow Glen, South Bascom, and San Carlos business districts. (The Rotary Club of San Jose West formed in 1946 as the “Beverly-Burbank Club”.)

In 2008, the Rotary Club of Campbell & San Jose West re-renamed itself the “Rotary Club of Campbell,” to reflect our strengthening community identity within the City of Campbell. The Club continues to serve a broad swath of west San Jose, which itself surrounds and envelopes most of Campbell proper. In 2011, the club was fortunate to also merge with the Rotary Club of Willow Glen. We now serve the Willow Glen community while continuing to call ourselves the Rotary Club of Campbell.

Through weekly meetings and club committee involvement, you will gain lifelong friendships you would not acquire otherwise. It is truly a club of fellowship, community and business connections like no other.

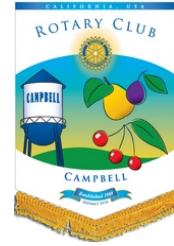
What Are My Commitments to Rotary?

Fellowship and Business Connections

Rotary membership has a certain prestige. You will meet many of the community's present and upcoming leaders. There will be opportunities to network, socialize, and develop business relationships with other club members. However, expecting to network and solicit business from other members should not be the motivation for joining Rotary. Members should refrain from networking for business purposes during club meetings. When members focus on Rotary activities, business opportunities will often appear at the most unexpected times.

Attendance

Rotary International has an attendance requirement for all members. You will be expected to attend at least 50% of the weekly meetings. When you cannot attend your regular weekly meeting, you can "make-up" at any Rotary club almost anywhere in the world. Attending meetings with other local clubs – as well as clubs in other states or other countries – has proven to be one of the highlights of being a Rotarian. When you walk into another club's meeting, you will instantly be surrounded by new friends and be welcomed warmly.
